3. FIRE-DAMAGED HOUSE, 135 DEEPALE DR., WAS DEMOLISHED END OF JULY; CAUSE OF FIRE DETERMINED.

The house, damaged in Feb, was razed the end of July. Liam Tanelli, the owner, said experts determined the cause of fire was a shorted outlet and a circuit breaker that failed to open. The inspector told him circuit breakers should be periodically replaced. Liam and Andrea Tanelli, and young children, plan to erect a modular house on same foundation, and move in by end of year. A Google search revealed NUMEROUS recommendations to test breakers yearly, (test ground fault breakers monthly), and replace breakers in certain conditions. **DETAILS:** <http://home.comcast.net/~oak-hill/2014/circuit-breaker.html>
