A 6th rabid raccoon tested positive, today, for rabies in Middletown (rte 35, between Kaness Lane and Kings Highway).

The previous rabid raccoon was reported on May 7, after being found off Red Hill Rd between Dwight and Deepdale in Oak Hill.

I don't recall numbers this high in the ~25 years I have lived in Oak Hill.

Dogs and cats must be vaccinated.

Avoid animals acting strangely. Report them immediately to Animal Control at 732-615-2097 or contact the Police Department after hours and on weekends.
