

OAK HILL RESIDENT DESCRIBES HER 2006 BURGLARY EXPERIENCE:

"The same thing happened January, 2006. There was a rash of break-in, and we [on Tatum] were one of them. Broke in the back slider door, stole all the jewelry, cell phone and laptop -- but because we could trace the phone and the laptop - the police caught him. He had hit a number of houses in the area. He did go to jail, but was released soon after and is still in the area (I know this because we get the notices when he doesn't appear for parole meetings).

The police had told us that they like to hit this area because of the quick access to the parkway. They can jump right on the parkway and head to Newark where they pawn the good jewelry. Advise people not to leave jewelry in a jewelry box on their dresser, or in top drawers of dressers or nightstand. It's the 1st place they look."
